### **Race Timing Chips**

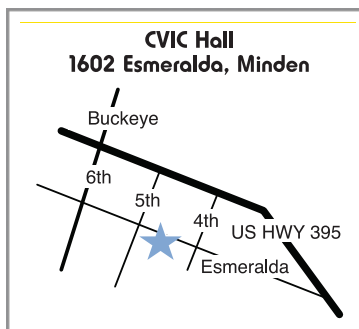
We need to get back all the race timing chips so we can refurbish them for next year.

We’re looking for new blood on the club’s board of directors. All officer positions are up for election at the annual meeting on November 2 and we’ll fill all the open positions for officials before dinner. The six elected officers are:

### President

Set location, time, and agenda and preside over all meetings. Develop agendas by obtaining status reports from all officers and officials and tracking all requests made of the club.

Serve as second signer on AACC checking account.

Ensure all activities are successfully planned and executed, by assigning or finding an appropriate individual or team to coordinate each.

Ensure that club members are informed of everything going on with the club.

Request and coordinate nominations for the next year’s club officers.

Attend local meetings regarding issues important to cyclists.

Write a column for each edition of the newsletter.

Keep club members’ best interests in mind

### Vice-President

Assist with organizing monthly and special board meetings, and membership meetings.

Preside over monthly and special board meetings, and membership meetings if the President is unable to attend.

Serve as alternate second signer on AACC checking account.

Assume responsibilities of vacant officer and official positions.

### Treasurer

Maintain financial accounts of the AACC including obtaining signatures for checking account, writing checks, making deposits, and providing the Board of Directors with a monthly statement of AACC finances.

Ensure that all tax forms are prepared and filed on time.

Serve as primary signer on AACC checking account.

Coordinate budget planning process with all officers and officials having budget responsibility. Present annual budget to BoD for approval.

### Secretary

Manage and archive AACC records as required in bylaws.

Prepare minutes for all Board of Directors and membership meetings, distribute to all board members for ratification, and provide to newsletter editor for publication.

Manage all elections including the printing and distribution of ballots, the counting of ballots, and the announcement of election results.

### Membership Coordinator

Manage and maintain membership database and system for sending to member email lists.

Update membership agreement as required and

maintain archive of signed membership agreements

Ensure membership webpage is current and provide updates to website coordinator.

Organize annual spring party.

Recruit new club members and contact those with expired memberships.

### Ride Coordinator

Organize weekend rides April through October.

Scout new ride locations and classify rides.

Recruit ride leaders as needed.

Devise ride schedule and send to newsletter editor and website coordinator.

Post weekend rides on rideboard.

Assist with the Challenge and other club events.

Promote participation in club events.

Meeting called to order at 6:07pm

October Minutes Approved [Chris/Tammy/Unanimous]

### 1. Monthly Status Reports:

- **Membership:** No increase in membership since October. Tod will send out a reminder for the membership meeting and will check-in members at the event. Guests will pay \$20 (the same cost as family membership upgrades) [Tod/Chris/Unanimous].
- **Treasurer:** The current checking account balance is: \$9732.85. The PayPal account balance is \$8,923.30.
- **Weekend Rides:** The weekend ride program has wrapped up for the year. The last ride was Tony's Auburn ride which was a fun day for everyone who drove out for this special ride.
- **Social Media:** Michael will check with Corby on his availability to continue in the role of social media coordinator in 2019.
- **Newsletter:** Michael will be publishing the November newsletter as soon as possible. This will be the last newsletter for 2018.
- **Website:** Jim has updated the home page to announce the annual meeting and fall party.
- **Weekly Road Races:** Michael confirmed that awards will be presented at the fall dinner. He is working on recovering about 70 outstanding race chips and budgeting for the refurbishing effort which will involve replacing missing chips, replacing the colored numbers with UV-resistant material and replacing the plastic mounts.
- **Junior Team:** The Alta Alpina Combined NICA team had a great season. Discussion of budgeting for the NICA team's needs will be tackled at the December board meeting.
- **Fall Century:** Thanks to Dave Scarborough for organizing a great event and to Hank Rowe for helping out at the rest stop. The temperature was low but otherwise the conditions were great and there was a good turnout.
- **Insurance:** Michael working to get policy written earlier this time around.

- **Bike Advocacy:** No report.
  - **Adopt A Highway:** Frank organized the third and final cleanup of the year. We're looking for a new coordinator for 2019.
  - **Clothing:** Lori reported that the April order for fashion kit items arrived in October and the vendor had increased the prices over the amounts that had been collected. She was able to get the vendor to accept the original price. We now have inventory of these items but the online store is no longer available. Michael will work to move the design to the Voler store.
  - **Challenge:** Michael is working on launching registration for 2019. Print ads, posters, post cards and registration forms are being designed and Dennis is updating the registration software. The goal is launch before Thanksgiving. Michael reports that 8 Pass Jerseys continue to sell to finishers. He has also been working on cleaning up the club storage unit. Two shelves must be repaired and the club tent needs to be replaced.
2. **Appointment of Secretary:** A motion to appoint Michael Bayer to the vacant position of secretary so that he can officiate at the annual meeting was passed. [Chris/Tammy/Unanimous].
  3. **Fall Dinner:** Lori reviewed the awesome menu that she had planned for the fall dinner. She has recruited help for catering the dinner which will have a Tex-Mex theme and feature many desserts. Michael will bring drinks from club supplies. We will be selling clothing inventory. Frank, Tod, and Chris will solicit for door prizes. Appetizers will be served at 6pm and dinner will be served after the business portion of the meeting. We won't have a dinner speaker but we'll ask members to tell us about their favorite events of the year. We'll end with awards and door prizes.
  4. **Marketing Budget:** Motion passed to authorize \$2500 for the Alta Alpina Challenge marketing budget. [Michael/Chris/Unanimous]
