
If you haven't yet taken your turn as a board member 2018 us the year to join! Check out the positions and contact Chris Rhiner if you have any questions.

# It Takes a Village

Have any ideas about how to improve the club? Have you taken your turn on the club's board yet? The annual meeting is your chance to take on a leadership position with your bicycle club!

Board members receive a free family membership and free racing. The board is made up of elected officers and all the other club officials.

We're looking for new blood on the club's board of directors. All officer positions are up for election at the annual meeting on November 2 and we'll fill all the open positions for officials before dinner. See the description below and consult the club website for more details for each position (Job Descriptions Page). Please let Chris Rhiner know what position(s) you're interested in.

The six elected officers are:

#### **President**

Set location, time, and agenda and preside over all meetings. Develop agendas by obtaining status reports from all officers and officials and tracking all requests made of the club.

Serve as second signer on AACC checking account.

Ensure all activities are successfully planned and executed, by assigning or finding an appropriate individual or team to coordinate each.

Ensure that club members are informed of everything going on with the club.

Request and coordinate nominations for the next vear's club officers.

Attend local meetings regarding issues important to cyclists.

Write a column for each edition of the newsletter.

Keep club members' best interests in mind

#### **Vice-President**

Assist with organizing monthly and special board meetings, and membership meetings.

Preside over monthly and special board meetings, and membership meetings if the President is unable to attend.

Serve as alternate second signer on AACC checking account.

Assume responsibilities of vacant officer and official positions.

#### **Treasurer**

Maintain financial accounts of the AACC including obtaining signatures for checking account, writing checks, making deposits, and providing the Board of Directors with a monthly statement of AACC finances.

Ensure that all tax forms are prepared and filed on time. Serve as primary signer on AACC checking account.

Coordinate budget planning process with all officers and officials having budget responsibility. Present annual budget to BoD for approval.

#### Secretary

Manage and archive AACC records as required in bylaws.

Prepare minutes for all Board of Directors and membership meetings, distribute to all board members for ratification, and provide to newsletter editor for publication.

Manage all elections including the printing and distribution of ballots, the counting of ballots, and the announcement of election results.

#### **Membership Coordinator**

Manage and maintain membership database and system for sending to member email lists.

Update membership agreement as required and

maintain archive of signed membership agreements

Ensure membership webpage is current and provide updates to website coordinator.

Organize annual spring party.

Recruit new club members and contact those with expired memberships.

#### **Ride Coordinator**

Organize weekend rides April through October.

Scout new ride locations and classify rides.

Recruit ride leaders as needed.

Devise ride schedule and send to newsletter editor and website coordinator.

Post weekend rides on rideboard.

Assist with the Challenge and other club events.

Promote participation in club events.

# **Board Meeting Minutes—October 2, 2017**

Secretary: Garth Jackson; Other Board Members: Tammy Lundquist (Vice President), Dave Scarborough (Weekend Ride Director), Jim Sadilek (Webmaster), Lori Piccini (Clothing Coordinator), Chris Rhiner (President)

Meeting called to order at 6:12 pm

- 1. Monthly Status Reports:
  - **Treasurer**: \$10,566.65 in bank account. \$3,761.52 in Paypal Account.
  - Membership: No Changes. Michael & Dennis Pederson starting revamp of the registration system.
  - Weekend Rides: Details of upcoming rides are posted on the rideboard. Fall century is the largest event upcoming, and Dave has worked the details of that event diligently.
  - Newsletter: Need prompt meeting minutes for the October meeting to release the newsletter in time for 21-day notification required for fall party. Newsletter is the notification source for the fall party.
  - Website: Jim and Lori have the updated club clothing page in prototype complete, but not released to the live club website. Michael is working on the Paypal button to allow people to order kits easily. Alternate method of club kit ordering is to manually hand a check to Lori.
  - **Junior Team**: No report. The season is active, and the juniors are attending local events.
  - Tim Rowe Memorial Fall Century: Dave has confirmed that everything is set for October 8th. Roughly one dozen RSVPs at this juncture. Dave needs to find the ride waiver for juniors since the boy scouts are going to ride a portion of the route. Carpool at Lampe will leave at 8:30AM.
  - Insurance: No Report.
  - · Bike Advocacy: No Report.
  - Adopt A Highway: Cleanup on September 24th went well. Slightly more trash picked up than usual. Two groups rode afterwards for road and MTB.
  - · Club Clothing: New items discussed at previous

- two meetings have arrived in time for fall party modeling. Jim and Lori's updated clothing page for the website has a list of inventory.
- Challenge: Motion to spend \$270.00 per ad for 5 ads with Cycle California, (1st: Dave s, 2nd: Garth J, Passed).
- Fall Party: Fall party is arranged for November 2nd at CVIC hall. Lori has agreed to provide catering for the event.
- Weekly Road Races: Members can return their RFID chips at the fall party November 2nd in order to get their deposit back. Costs for the season are roughly \$2k for the race stewards, and \$2k for the race timing system. Additional cost for porta-potty & other items still to be tabulated.
- 2. **Annual Meeting Elections:** Fall Party will vote in new board members. Encourage other club members to investigate positions that may interest them.
- Spring Century 2018: Dave proposed changing Ray Rickard Spring Century to a metric century to encourage social engagement of club members. Alternative venues for the start/finish/BBQ were discussed.
- Membership Fees: Motion to increase membership dues from \$25 to @30 for individuals, and \$40 to \$50 for families. (1st Dave S, 2nd Tammy L, Pass).
- 5. **New Volunteer Groups:** Dave and Tammy are talking with Heavenly ski area representatives next week about sponsoring a rest stop for the Challenge.
- 6. **Next Meeting:** Thursday, Nov 2, 2017, 6 pm, CVIC Hall in Minden.
  - Meeting adjourned at 7:25 pm
